

- 1933 The first meeting of our Society, then called the Wahroonga Horticultural Society, was held at St John's Church, Wahroonga on 27th April, 1933.
- 1939 The outbreak of WW2. The society was kept going by a group known as 'The Ladies of Roseville'.
- 1946 The Society was revived and renamed the Ku-ring-gai Horticultural Society. Meetings were held at Marian St Memorial Hall, Killara.
- 1950 Our longest serving President, His Honour Judge Markell resigned after 14 years in office.
- 1956 New initiatives were introduced, including the Show Bench, Garden Table, member and Guest Speakers. Five flower shows, open to the public were held each year.
- 1968 Meeting venue was changed to St John's Church Hall, Gordon, where it remained for 32 years.
- 1972 First Society organized bus trip was to Leura and Mt Wilson and cost \$2.20. We now run several outing each year.
- 1983 Affiliated with the Royal Horticultural Society.
- 1987 Affiliated with Garden Clubs of Australia.
- 2000 Meetings moved to the Community Hall, St Ives.
- 2003 We celebrated our 70th anniversary in style.
- 2008 We celebrated our 75th anniversary.
- 2009 Participated in the Ku-ring-gai Garden Expo and Garden Clubs of Australia Convention in Tamworth.
